Greetings from Colorado! Yes, I have been in the States now for a little over 2 weeks. The flight went well. There were few restrictions because of COVID, but other than being very long, it went very well. It has been good to be with my family. I have already seen 2 sisters and a brother. Another brother and his wife will be coming into town next week. It has been good to to touch base with each of them. Thank you for praying that our time together would be profitable for Eternity.
