So, as you can see being involved in as much ministry as possible, plus all the "house activities", this has been a busy few months. Thank you so much for your faithful partnership during this time in praying and giving. Truly it is what has make it possible for me to be here.

Over these last few months here in San Jacinto we were able to have kids' Bible club, adult meetings as well as youth activities. Some of this had stopped over the Summer months. We are thankful to be able to get all of that up and going again. For now, we are having the Bible club in the park in front of my old house. Pray for direction as to what the Lord would have us do as Winter is fast approaching. Move it to where I am now living is a possibility. David and Silvia (the new missionaries) have started an activity for adolescents. I attend when I can. Thank you for praying for Mica, the little gal that did not want to leave her house. She came to the adolescent group a couple of times then stopped. Her brother Joel also attended for several weeks but has also stopped coming. What a need we see in these young lives. Pray for the three young ladies that <u>are</u> attending faithfully (Jade, Victoria, and Romina). Pray for their salvation and their outreach to the kids around them.

I continue a weekly study with Luisa, Victoria's grandmother. Her understanding of the Gospel continues to grow. her family. Ernesto attends every so often with his mother. Pray as we continue to reach out into that small town.

FEBU started this week. There are four full time students plus a good number part time. Some of those are young people who are working and studying other things. In addition, there are several from local churches taking one or two classes. It is great to see FEBU reaching out in this way to assist the local churches. Because of scheduling I will not be teaching this semester.

Just a couple of last things to pray for: We have our annual ladies retreat March 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>. Pray for those teaching and participating in different ways. I talked to the principal at the grade school about teaching English. She is new to the school but did express interest. She needs to have it approved but promised to let me know. Pray for direction and those ladies that will be participating.
