Dear Ones,

Thank you so much for praying for the inauguration. We were very thankful to see and participate in what the Lord is doing. There were believers from three different churches plus 8 adults and 4 children visiting from here in San Jacinto. All of them were contacts of ours in one way or another and only one of them knows the Lord. Pray with us as we seek to follow up with each of them as well as use the building to the Lord's Glory.

Let me try to bring you up to date on the other happenings:

Virginia (Bejamin's mom) and I are having a weekly Evangelistic study now on Saturday mornings. She is very open to hearing the Word and seeks to see what it has to do with her life. Pray for Salvation. She was at the meeting Sunday night along with Benja.

The study with Nelva continues to be off and on. She does have a sporadic work schedule and lots of different activities. Please pray that the Lord would give her a desire above all else to hear His Word and to know Him. She was also at the meeting on Sunday.
